1st Percussion

vibraphone, tuned gongs (B3 to E5), large rattle, tubular bells, xylophone, whip, 2: scallop shells & 締め太鼓 (or high conga)

2nd Percussion

拍子木 (or claves), 碰铃 (or triangle), snare drum, 編木 (or large güiro), very gross chain, marching drum (or piccolo snare drum) & ethnic drum

3rd Percussion

bass drum, metal wind-chimes, tam-tam, triangle (on stand), small rattle, floor tom, high wood-block & BOOF

4th Percussion
